#### DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSES:

Tallulah Falls School offers dual enrollment courses to qualified juniors and seniors where they receive credit at both Tallulah Falls School and Truett-McConnell College. This allows students to accelerate their high school and college careers by accumulating college credit while completing their high school graduation requirements at Tallulah Falls School.

Truett-McConnell College is a private 4 year liberal arts college accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. Students wishing to be dual enrolled must meet the SAT/ACT requirements for Truett-McConnell College and the University System of Georgia. Tallulah Falls School employs teachers that meet the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools qualifications to teach college courses. These teachers are adjunct professors of Truett-McConnell College. The texts and syllabi are provided by Truett-McConnell College.

Tallulah Falls School offers 16 dual enrollment courses in English, Math, Science, and Social Studies Theses courses are outlined in the program of study.
